The teaching this weekend looks at God's moves in the past, present and future and the moves we need to make to get to know Him more.

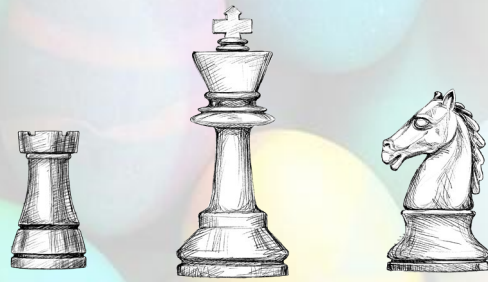
We will also have Praise, crafts, games and a lot of fun...so come prepared to get involved!
